KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working in the Shelter, Attendants will:
 - maintain safety of the site
 - provide First Aid
 - de-escalate crisis
 - providing community resources to clients
 - providing meals as needed
 - accepting clients into the shelter throughout the night
 - doing wellness checks
- Communicate with Extreme Weather Shelter volunteers at the beginning and end of shifts any necessary information
- Perform other duties necessary for the enhancement of the program as directed by a Shelter/Outreach Worker or supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education, Training, and Experience

- Current Level I First Aid certificate required
- Non-Violent Crisis Intervention training required
- Naloxone training required (training can be provided)
- Crisis Line training an asset.
