- Spend a minimum of 2 meetings (1.5-2 hour per session every 2 weeks or a total of 10 hours) to engage in a mutually agreed-upon location and time. (In person, telephone, e mail or Skype)
- Serve as a positive role model to inspire and encourage newcomer mentees in achieving their career goals
- Provide industry - specific knowledge and expertise to support Mentees with their integration to the Canadian labour market
- Connect and introduce Mentees to networking events and conferences specific to their industry to help build social circle and professional network
