

JOB AD COMMUNITY WORKER CANADA SUMMER JOB – 2024

Options Community Services Society (OCS) is a not-for-profit social services organization providing social services south of the Fraser River from early years to seniors. Options Community Services is seeking a passionate and dedicated youth to join our team for the Canada Summer Jobs 2024 program. This is a temporary full-time position dependent on funding.

As a Community Worker, your primary responsibility will be to establish and nurture relationships with a diverse range of community groups, fostering connections to create a supportive network for those in need. You will actively engage in program planning, contribute to educational material development, and assist with special summer events, drop-in activities at the park, and regular programming at the Family Resource Center (FRP).

Responsibilities:

- Collaborating in program planning, development, and enhancement of educational materials and special projects.
- Contributing to the planning and execution of special summer events, drop-in activities, and regular programming at the FRP.
- Handling administrative tasks such as answering phones, photocopying, filing, data entry, office organization, and compiling statistics.
- Assisting in planning, preparing, and implementing early literacy activities.

The ideal candidate for this role is a compassionate and motivated individual with a genuine passion for supporting isolated families in the community. Previous experience in social services or related field is desirable. You possess excellent communication and organizational skills, coupled with a proactive and collaborative approach to community engagement. Your ability to adapt to a dynamic work environment, coupled with a commitment to promoting inclusivity and building strong community connections, will make you a valuable addition to our team.

This role will require the incumbent to undergo a Police Information Check (PIC), and a Vulnerable Sector Check by the Ministry of Justice. This position will be paid at an hourly rate of \$16.75.

Eligibility Requirement:

To be eligible, youth must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the beginning of the employment period.
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act for the duration of the employment; and,



• have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.
